2025 Price Anchors

Pine saplings 3-4 ft: about \$30 - \$50.

6-7 ft pines: about \$100 - \$300.

15 ft mature evergreens: about \$800 - \$2,500+ depending on species and form.

Eastern White Pine typically on the lower end; Japanese Black Pine on the higher end.

Size vs Value

Smaller trees cost less and establish faster, but take years to reach screening height. 10-15 ft gives instant impact, but needs pro equipment and tighter first-season care. Many pines add roughly 1 - 2 ft per year with good care.

Where to Buy & Markups

Grower nurseries/farms: transparent pricing, pick the exact specimen, stronger warranties.

Garden centers: convenience markup about 20% - 40%.

Landscape companies: about +30% - +50% over grower price but include logistics and install.

Online stores: wider selection - verify height measurement and shipping terms.

Planting Labor & Gear

Average pro planting line item can be around \$300, but varies by size and access.

10 - 20 ft trees may need a loader or small crane and a 2 - 3 person crew.

Confirm scope: watering in, a 2 - 3 inch mulch ring, staking/guying, debris haul-away.

Hidden & Extra Costs

Site prep: stump/rock removal, soil amendments, irrigation tweaks.

Access surcharges: narrow gates, slopes, soft lawns - use protection mats.

First-season care: watering, mulch top-ups, deer protection.

Logistics & Access

Measure gates/paths, turning radius, and truck approach for a flatbed or nursery truck. Book morning installs to reduce heat stress; strap trees against wind. Write down who is responsible for any transit or on-site damage.

Best Timing & Deals

Dormant season (early spring or fall) improves success and often pricing. Ask for off-peak discounts, cosmetic-grade pricing, or bundle deals for rows. Reserve stock early in high-demand regions to avoid price spikes.

Paperwork & Warranty

Itemized quote: tree, delivery, equipment, installation, materials, warranty terms. Written first-year care notes and a claims contact with response times. Clear replacement policy if a tree fails within the warranty window.

Ways to Save

Mix sizes: a few large anchors plus smaller fillers to lower total cost. Choose hardy, locally common species for your zone to reduce losses. DIY light tasks if allowed: mulch ring and deer guards.
