- Water is the Enemy: Proactively manage moisture. Keep your gutters clean and ensure the ground slopes away from your foundation.
- **Protect the Wood:** Your cabin's stain is its shield against sun and rain. Inspect it annually. If water no longer beads on the surface, it's time for a fresh coat (typically every 3-5 years).
- **Annual Inspection:** At least once a year, walk around the cabin and inspect all seals and caulking around windows, doors, and between logs.
